INVITATION TO PARTICIPATION IN PRELIMINARY MARKET CONSULTATION

TRAFFIC MANAGEMENT SYSTEM CONTROL LEVEL FOR HSL

Dear ladies and gentlemen,

Správa železnic, with registered office at Dlážděná 1003/7, 110 00, Prague 1 – Nové Město, ID No.: 01312774, entered in the Commercial Registry with the Municipal Court in Prague, file No. A 48384, represented by Jakub Bazgier, Director of High-Speed Lines Construction Management (hereinafter referred to as the **"Contracting Authority"**), is approaching you to kindly request your participation in the preliminary market consultation (hereinafter referred to as the **"Consultation"**), which will be conducted with the aim of preparing the Terms of Reference and informing the prospective suppliers about the intentions and requirements of the Contracting Authority regarding the deliverables under the upcoming public procurement for the Traffic Management System (TMS) Control Level for High-Speed Lines (HSL) (hereinafter referred to as the **"Public Procurement"**).

I. Purpose and aim of the Consultation

The objective of the Public Procurement is to create a traffic management system for high-speed lines in the Czech Republic, which will be implemented and operated in the traffic control centres (TCC or CDP in Czech) in Prague and Přerov.

The aim of the Public Procurement is to select the supplier of the traffic management system who will be obliged to design, deliver, install and test the required system, ensure its commissioning including relevant approvals and subsequently provide comprehensive maintenance and support services for a total period of 30 years, covering the entire service life of the system.

More detailed information on the Public Procurement is provided in Appendices 2-5 to this invitation.

A similar public procurement has never been implemented on such a scale in the Czech Republic before. The purpose of the Consultation is to familiarise potential suppliers with the Public Procurement and to open a discussion on the specifics of the Public Procurement and the Terms of Reference which the Contracting Authority is considering. The Consultation shall define the subject of the Public Procurement and set the Terms of Reference, so that they best meet the needs of the Contracting Authority and at the same time, together with the subject of the Public

Procurement, are set in accordance with Act No. 134/2016 Coll., on Public Procurement, as amended (hereinafter referred to as the "**Act**"), in particular with the principle of proportionality and other principles regulated in Section 6 of the Act.

For the avoidance of doubt, the Contracting Authority states that this invitation relates solely to participation in the Consultation pursuant to Section 33 of the Public Procurement Act, it is not an invitation to express preliminary interest, nor is it an invitation to submit applications for participation or bids in the Public Procurement.

II. Expected programme of the Consultation

The opportunity to participate in the Consultation is open to all professionals and contractors (hereinafter referred to collectively as "**Suppliers**") who are interested in the Public Procurement. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to conduct the Consultation in multiple rounds using written communication and through physical or online meetings with the Suppliers.

The Consultation will be conducted in Czech and English, with possible interpretation between these two languages.

Suppliers acknowledge that all information provided to them in the Consultation is confidential and is for the sole purpose of the Consultation.

To participate in the Consultation, the Suppliers are first required to confirm their interest in participating **by sending the completed and signed Preliminary Market Consultation Registration Form – TMS Control Level for HSL** (hereinafter referred to as the "**Registration Form**"), which is provided in Appendix No. 1 to this Invitation, by e-mail to the Contracting Authority's contact by the deadline specified below in Article III of this Invitation.

The first round of the Consultation will be **a written questionnaire to be completed by** the Suppliers. The questionnaire is about the technical parameters under consideration, the economic parameters and the definition of the subject of the Public Procurement. The questions in the questionnaire will be divided into the following groups:

- general questions,
- questions on system availability,
- questions on traffic control rooms.

If, after the evaluation of the questionnaires received, the Contracting Authority concludes that it is necessary to carry out another round of Consultation, then the Contracting Authority reserves the right to continue the Consultation in any form (questionnaire, personal or online meeting), while the Contracting Authority may, depending on its needs and the result of the first round of Consultation, address either all or only some Suppliers for the next round.

The Contracting Authority always decides the necessary format of the Consultation and the Suppliers have no legal right to it.

By responding to this invitation and by participating in the Consultation, the participant gives its explicit consent to the processing of any personal data. The personal data of the participants' representatives will be processed by the Contracting Authority only for the purposes of the Consultation and, where applicable, the review of legality of the Public Procurement.

A written record will be made of the Consultation, summarising key information from the Consultation.

The Suppliers will be informed by the Contracting Authority of the end of the Consultation.

III. Consultation dates and Supplier's application

The written questionnaire for the first round of the Consultation will be sent to those Suppliers who confirm their participation in the Consultation by submitting a completed and signed Registration Form **by 14 April 2025**. The written questionnaire will be sent by the Contracting Authority's contact to the e-mail address listed under "Consultation Contact" in the Registration Form.

The submission deadline for the completed written questionnaire for the first round of the Consultation is **12 May 2025**.

The Suppliers acknowledge and accept that a recording (audio, audio-visual or written) may be made of the Consultation for the purpose of reviewing and archiving the information provided.

Participants in the Consultation further acknowledge that all information provided to them in the Consultation is confidential and is for the sole purpose of the Consultation.

IV. Contracting Authority's reservations

For the avoidance of doubt, the Contracting Authority states that this invitation relates solely to participation in the Consultation and does not initiate any procurement procedure.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to modify the Terms of Reference of the Consultation or to terminate the Consultation at any time.

The results of the Consultation shall not be understood as bids in a procurement procedure. Participation in the Consultation does not confer any rights or obligations on the Supplier in future procurements.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to disregard communications, documents and comments from relevant Suppliers in languages other than Czech, Slovak or English.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to require the Suppliers to supplement or clarify the information they have submitted. The Contracting Authority reserves the right to evaluate and use the conclusions of the Consultation at its discretion.

The Contracting Authority reserves the right to identify in the Terms of Reference of the Public Procurement the persons who participated in the Consultation and to provide all relevant information that was the content of the Consultation.

The Suppliers shall bear their own costs associated with their participation in the Consultation and the Contracting Authority shall not be obliged to contribute to the costs in any way.
