

EXPLANATION OF THE TENDER DOCUMENTATION No. 1

The Contracting Authority received a written request for clarification of the Tender Documentation from a prospective contractor.

The Contracting Authority hereby provides an explanation of the Tender Documentation (Tender Specifications) for the above-mentioned Public Contract in accordance with Section 98 of the PPA, in both Czech and English, including the exact wording of the request for explanation of the Tender Documentation without identifying the prospective contractor who requested the explanation.

Inquiry by the prospective contractor if the explanation was provided following a request for clarification	
1.	<p>In the qualification conditions, clause 6.1.3.c), the professional competence of the participant is required:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Authorisation of the CKA with general scope and the numerical designation A.0 or authorization of the CKA for the field of architecture with the numerical designation A1 - CKA authorisation for landscape architecture with the number designation A.3 <p>We would like to confirm with you that in the second point, the CKA authorisation for landscape architecture with the numerical designation A.3 can be replaced by the CKA authorisation with general scope and numerical designation A.0 (as in the first point).</p> <p>The CKA authorisation with general scope and the number designation A.0 covers A.1, A.2 and A.3 without exception. According to the Czech Chamber of Architects, it is not possible to require A.3 and not accept A.0.</p>
Explanation of the Contracting Authority	
1.	<p>The Public Contract is announced, as stated on its title page, inter alia, in accordance with Act No. 360/1992 Sb., on the Exercise of Profession of Authorised Architects and Profession of Authorised Engineers and Technicians Active in Construction, as amended (the "Act on the Exercise of Profession").</p> <p>Section 4(3) of the Act on the Exercise of Profession stipulates that the Czech Chamber of Architects shall grant a general authorisation to persons who meet the conditions for authorisation in all fields referred to in paragraph 2 (i.e. the field of</p>

	<p>architecture - authorisation A.1, the field of town planning - authorisation A.2, the field of landscape architecture - authorisation A.3). This authorisation entitles to perform activities in the fields referred to in paragraph 2(a) to (c).</p> <p>If the Contracting Authority has announced the Public Contract in accordance with the Act on the Exercise of Profession and the Act expressly provides that the authorisation with general scope (A.0) authorises the performance of activities for which it would otherwise be necessary to demonstrate authorisation A.1 / A.2 / A.3, it is clear that the Contracting Authority will recognise the submission of an A.0 (general scope) authorisation as equivalent to the required A.3 (landscape architecture) authorisation, without the need to explicitly state this fact in the Tender Documentation.</p>
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Capitalized terms used in this explanation, unless otherwise specified, shall have the meanings as set forth in the definitions in the Tender Documentation.

For the avoidance of any doubt, the Contracting Authority states that the provision of the above clarification does not change the Tender Documentation within the meaning of Sections 98(5) and 99 of the PPA and the deadline for submission of the Application for Participation remains unaffected.
