For the purposes of participation in the Procurement Procedure, the contracting authorities of which are

- 1) the City of Prague, represented by the Department of Property Management of the City of Prague,
- 2) Prague Public Transit Company, joint-stock company
- 3) Správa železnic, state organisation

(the "Contracting Authority"),

the Participant hereby declares that he:

the possible future selection of its Final Draft Design, the conclusion of the Contract or the performance of the Public Contract will not violate the laws and decisions governing international sanctions in relation to Article 5k of Council Regulation (EU) No 833/2014 or other relevant sanctions regulations to which the Czech Republic or the Contracting Authority is bound (in relation to the sanctions adopted against Russia and Belarus), and further declares that

**A) meets the condition for participation under par. 6.1.1 of the Tender Documentation, i.e. that:**

Neither the Participant nor any of the authors or co-authors or their collaborators who will participate in the preparation of the Approach Methodology / Concept / Draft Design / Bid, and if the Participant is a legal entity, nor the governing body or any member of that governing body:

- 1) has directly participated in the preparation of the Tender Documentation, the Competition Brief, or any part thereof, except for persons who prepared the underlying mapping or analytical documents;
- 2) is a full member or alternate of the jury (evaluation committee) or an invited expert or organiser of the Procurement Procedure;
- 3) is a spouse / registered partner, direct relative, first-degree brother-in-law or sister-in-law, permanent project partner, immediate superior or direct collaborator of the persons listed in points 1) and 2) above;
- 4) is a member of the Contracting Authority's self-governing bodies or an employee of the Contracting Authority's agencies or legal entities established by the Contracting Authority who participated in the negotiation and approval of the tender terms and conditions, the Competition Brief, or who will participate in the negotiation and approval of the results of the Competition Dialogue, the negotiation about the conclusion of the Contract and the approval of the conclusion of the Contract.

**B) meets the condition for participation under par. 6.1.2 of the Tender Documentation, i.e. that:**

- 1) he has not been finally convicted, in the country of his domicile in the last 5 years prior to the commencement of the Competition Dialogue, of a criminal offence committed for the benefit of an organised criminal group or the offence of participation in an organised criminal group, the offence of trafficking in human beings, the offences against property: fraud, credit fraud, subsidy fraud, laundering of proceeds of crime, laundering of proceeds of crime through negligence, economic crimes: abuse of information and position in commercial relations, negotiation of an advantage in the award of a public contract, in a public tender and in a public auction, intrigue in the award of a public contract and in a public tender, intrigue in a public auction, damage to the financial interests of the European Union, for offences of a generally dangerous nature, for offences against the Czech Republic, a foreign state and an international organisation, offences against public order: offences against the exercise of authority of a public agency and an official person, offences by public officials, bribery and other interference with the activities of a public authority, or a similar offence under the law of the country of the Participant's domicile; spent convictions shall be disregarded;

and if the Participant is a legal entity, the Participant also declares that the condition under point B) 1. above is met by both the legal entity and its governing body or each member of the governing body, and if the Participant's governing body or a member of the Participant's governing body is a legal entity, the condition under point B) 1. above is met by both the legal entity and its governing body or each member of the governing

body of the legal entity and the person representing the legal entity in the Participant's governing body;

and if the Participant is a branch office of a foreign legal entity, the Participant also declares that the condition under point B) 1. above is met by both the legal entity and the head of the branch office;

and if the Participant is a branch office of a Czech legal entity, the Participant also declares that the condition under point B) 1. above is met by both the legal entity and its governing body or each member of the governing body, the person representing the legal entity in the Participant's governing body and the head of the branch office;

- 2) he has no tax arrears due and registered in the Czech Republic or the country of his registered office, not even in respect of excise tax;
- 3) he has no outstanding insurance or health insurance contributions or any penalty therefrom in the Czech Republic or in the country of his registered office;
- 4) he has no outstanding social security payment or contribution to the national employment policy or any penalty therefrom in the Czech Republic or in the country of his registered office;
- 5) he is not in liquidation, has not been subject to a bankruptcy order, has not been placed under receivership under another legal regulation, and is not in a similar situation under the law of the country of the Participant's registered office.

**C) is registered in the Commercial Register of the Czech Republic: NO**

**D) holds a trade license for the field "Design Work in Construction" pursuant to Act No. 455/1991 Sb., on Trade Licensing (Trade Licensing Act), as amended: NO**

**E) holds a document certifying the professional eligibility of the Participant or the person through whom the Participant ensures professional eligibility, i.e. specifically:**

- **the CCA's authorisation with general scope and the numerical designation A.0** within the meaning of Section 4(3) of the Act on the Exercise of Profession, **or the CCA's authorisation for the field of architecture and with the numerical designation A.1, or a foreign equivalent of either of these authorisations** within the meaning of Section 4(2)(a) of the Act on the Exercise of Profession (except where no such document is issued under the law of the country in which the architect concerned has their registered office or of which he is a citizen); and
- **the CCA's authorisation for the field of landscape architecture and with the numerical designation A.3** within the meaning of Section 4(2)(a) of the Act on the Exercise of Profession **or a foreign equivalent** (except where no such document is issued under the law of the country in which the architect concerned has their registered office or of which he is a citizen).

**F) meets the condition of participation under par. 6.1.4 of the Tender Documentation, i.e. has an implementation team consisting of two to three architects (in the sense of natural persons) who will participate in the preparation of the Approach Methodology / Concept / Draft Design**


**/ Final Draft Design and, if the Contract is awarded to the Participant, also in the performance of the Public Contract, whereas:**

- A. at least one of the architects must be the authorised person** pursuant to Section 4(3) of the Act on the Exercise of Profession, or the authorised person pursuant to Section 4(2)(a) of the Act on the Exercise of Profession, or the authorised person according to the law of the state of which he is citizen or in which he has registered office, i.e. the **CCA's authorisation with general scope and numerical designation A.0 is required, or CCA's authorisation for the field of architecture and numerical designation A.1, or a foreign equivalent** (except for cases where, under the law of the country, in which the architect concerned has their registered office or of which he is a citizen, such document is not issued);
- B. at least one of the architects must be the authorised person** pursuant to Section 4(2)(c) of the Act on the Exercise of Profession, or the authorised person according to the law of the state of which he is citizen or in which he has registered office, i.e. the **CCA's authorisation for the field of landscape architecture and with the numerical designation A.3 or a foreign equivalent** is required (except for cases where, under the law of the country, in which the architect concerned has their registered office or of which he is a citizen, such document is not issued); and simultaneously
- C. any of the architects comprising the Participant's implementation team prepared (as the author or a co-author) or participated in the preparation, as lead architect or responsible designer, of the following reference contracts:**
  - 1. at least 1 Architectural Study or Documentation of public space (e.g. squares, embankments, streets, marketplaces, pavements, parks, parking lots and other spaces accessible to everyone without restriction, i.e. serving general use, regardless of ownership of the space), whereas:**
    - the public space had an area of at least 1,000 sq. m;
    - the public space for which the member of the implementation team prepared the Architectural Study or Documentation was actually constructed between 1 January 2000 and the time of the commencement of this Procurement Procedure;
  - 2. at least one Architectural Study or Documentation of a new building (set of new buildings), reconstruction / reconstruction with an extension of a Building or Hall of the Civil Construction, where:**
    - the Building or Hall of the Civil Construction for which the member of the implementation team prepared the Architectural Study or Documentation was actually constructed between 1 January 2000 and the time of the commencement of this Procurement Procedure.
